CURRICULUM FOR MIDDLE & HIGH SCHOOL



RULES AND REGULATION OF SSIT

1. Guardians have to obey all SSIT rules (which may be changed from time to time).
2. Parents of SSIT must pray obligatory salah five times a day.
3. While coming to meet their wards the guardians of SSIT must be in islamic dress, particularly ladies must come to school in proper attire.
4. An identity card will be given to all the guardians of SSIT for attending the guardians meeting as well as to meet their wards. Without identity card no one will be permitted to attend guardians meeting nor to be allowed to visit their wards.
5. Father/Mother or any other representative from students family must attend the guardian meeting.
6. Guardians are bound to follow the final decision of management in all respect of childrens studies, exams, progress or regress, their conduct and other performances.
7. Students cannot keep with them costly watch, mobile, gold articles, cameras, radios, tape-recorders, knives, blade, money, matches etc in hostel.
8. Students are not allowed to go outside of the school without prior permission from the authority.
9. Admission fee is not refundable to the students if he/she does not come to school after admission.
10. For hostel students parents can visit their ward in first and third sunday of every month.

11. No student will be handed over the person other than his/her guardians or the person authorised by the guardians.
12. The guardians must inform the authority about his/her wards serious illness that has been running for a long time.
13. If any student gets attacked with an Infectious diseases must join the school with doctors authorization.
14. Students voluntary absence from school may be considered to be an infringement of discipline, for which necessary steps will be taken.
15. The guardians have to inform the authority about their change of address or phone no.
16. Guardians must send their students in clean and ironed uniforms along with a water bottle.
17. The guardians must daily check their students CW, HW, project and assignment and other tasks before signing in School Diary.
18. On the every reopening day after any vacation if the child becomes absent, he/she must have to pay Rs/-250 rupees as late fine.
19. All the rules and regulation must be followed by the students/parents of SSIT

LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION:

1. Copy of the Birth Certificate
 2. Copy of Report Card of previous School (only needed for admission to class 3 onwards)
 3. Photocopy of Aadhar of Child and both parents/Guardians
 4. Proof of Address where presently residing
 5. Original TC from the previous school (for students seeking admission from class 3 onwards)
 6. 5 Passport size photograph each of Student and Parent
 7. Photocopy of Passport if available. This is mandatory for overseas students.
- Original Certificates may be produced at the time of admission for verification
All photocopies are required to be self attested at the time of submission

ACCEPTANCE OF ADMISSION:

1. Students are admitted on First Come, First Served basis depending on vacancies
2. Selected candidates will be required to make the fee payment after declaration of the result.
3. The school reserves the right to admissions. In all matters pertaining to admission, the decision of the Admission Committee will be final.
4. Parents will be intimated of the date and time of uniform & textbook issue

ADMISSION PROCESS

For the pre-primary classes, an interview with the student and guardian must be conducted. For the primary and higher classes, a written test will be followed by an interview with the candidates and the guardians. The syllabus of the admission test will include English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, and General Knowledge. The test will be out of 50 marks. To fulfill the admission criteria, the guardian must produce the original Birth Certificate, Transfer Certificate, four color passport-size photographs, Aadhar Card, etc.
